Terms of Scholarship

It is understood that the agency may be awarded a scholarship for sending an officer to the 40-hour CIT training class. To receive this scholarship (and to continue to receive scholarships), the agency must agree to complete the CIT Officer Report. Forms are provided in class and can be obtained from a Co-Coordinator at any time. These may be completed by hand or on the website.

The amount of the scholarship may vary and is available on a first-come first-serve basis until funds are depleted.

Travel and manpower replacement expenses are included in this scholarship. The funding for the scholarship will be paid after the officer completes the 40-hour CIT class. In the event the officer fails to complete the 40-hour class, the scholarship will be cancelled and no funds will be paid.
